Station 1 Prayer:

Station 3 Prayer:

Station 4 Prayer:

Station 5 Prayer:

Station 7 Prayer:

Praying the Labyrinth

Praying a labyrinth is a form of contemplative prayer, a slow, and meditative walk, pausing and praying each time there is a turn or change of direction. Our prayer for creation is inspired by Pope Francis' Laudate Deum (Praise God).

At the Entrance

1. We praise you, O God, Creator of all things.
2. Your mysteries unfold in a leaf, a mountain, a dewdrop, and in a poor person's face.
3. Jesus, your Son, taught us to wonder -
4. As he made his way throughout the land, contemplating the beauty of creation.
5. We pray, O God, that you may stir in us -
6. A reverent awareness of our invisible link with the entire created world.
7. We pray for humility -
8. To remember that we, too, are created and are not creation's masters.
9. We pray for compassion -
10. For open eyes and hearts to welcome those forced to flee from their homes due to rising sea levels and drought.
11. We pray for repentance -
12. So that our thirst for power and domination may be transformed into service.
13. We pray for simplicity -
14. And the will to turn from our greed which impacts vulnerable people everywhere.
15. We pray for cultural conversion -
16. That we may simplify our lifestyles, reduce pollution and waste, and exercise prudence in our decision-making.
