- ✓ BIG IDEA During this series, we could easily spend small group time debating the hot topics; however, since our goal is to build unity, the group discussion guides are centered around that concept. Unity depends on maturity. Our individual spiritual growth must become a priority so that we develop a maturity that brings us together in love even when we disagree.

- Think of someone you know who embodies maturity and wisdom. Share with the group why this person has made this impression on you.
- Read Mark 14:66-72 aloud. Now, read Acts 4:1-14 aloud. What a transformation! Name a few characteristics Peter demonstrates in the second passage.
- Take a moment and think about your spiritual growth. Share with the group a way that you have changed since you first decided to follow Christ.
- What has helped you grow the most in your faith?
- Maturity and wisdom are things we can actively foster in our lives. As we grow in these qualities, we become more able to show love even when we don't agree. 2 Peter 1:5-7 says, "This is why you must make every effort to add moral excellence to your faith; and to moral excellence, knowledge; and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, endurance; and to endurance, godliness; and to godliness, affection for others; and to affection for others, love." [CEB] We are told to "make every effort" to pursue this personal growth and the end result is love. What can you make a greater effort to do that will lead you down this path? Share some ideas as a group.
- / Pray Gracious God, we thank you for sharing with us the characteristics we should be pursuing in order to become wise, loving followers of Christ. These things are not easy but we know you have called us to be persistent as we learn more about your ways and grow in our love for each other. Help us to encourage each other as we grow closer together and unite in bringing your love to others. Amen.
