THOUGHT

SCRIPTURE 1 Thessalonians 3:12

"May the Lord make your love increase and overflow for each other and for everyone else, just as ours does for you." [NIV] Our love for each other should continually increase and overflow. As we learn more about the thoughts and experiences of those around us, we are called to increase in our love and appreciation for each other. Rather than seeing differences as things that divide us, we can choose to view these differences as valuable and special to God.

GROUP GUIDE

- ✓ PRAYER God, we acknowledge that you are already here. May our hearts be open to your presence and direction. Amen.
- ✓ BIG IDEA During this series, we could easily spend small group time debating the hot topics; however, since our goal is to build unity, the group discussion guides are centered around that concept. Unity does not mean uniformity. We are stronger because of our diversity of thought and the way we embrace the unique contribution of each member of the body of Christ.

/ DISCUSS

- Share an example of when you have felt that your experiences, ideas, or unique abilities were recognized or utilized in a particular situation. How did that feel?
- Have you experienced a time when your unique strengths were not celebrated or maybe even caused tension? What would you say was the source of that tension?
- What do you think is the biggest stumbling block for people when it comes to identifying and utilizing their unique abilities and ideas within the church?
- Read 1 Corinthians 12:4-7 aloud. "There are different spiritual gifts but the same Spirit; and there are different ministries and the same Lord; and there are different activities but the same God who produces all of them in everyone. A demonstration of the Spirit is given to each person for the common good." [CEB] Unity requires us to agree that we have one Spirit guiding and equipping, one God we glorify, and one mission--to share the love of Jesus with all people. It does not require that the how, where, and when are the same! In fact, the more diversity in the methods, the farther the reach of the Church will be. Share with the group how your individual strengths and experiences might contribute to the mission of the Church.
- In verse 7 of the above passage, we read, "A demonstration of the Spirit is given to each person for the common good." [CEB] The New Living Translation says, "A spiritual gift is given to each of us so we can help each other." Our uniqueness is for the benefit of each other and should be celebrated! This verse suggests that the whole is strengthened by its diversity, yet sometimes we try to conform or force conformity. Why do you think that might be the case?
- Pray Gracious God, we give thanks for the many ways you are represented by your people. Help us remember that your greatness is so immense that it takes all of us together to reflect that greatness, each in our own unique ways, to those who need to experience your love. Amen.
