DIGGING DEEPER

✓ Intro

This week we learned some important truths from the story of Noah and the flood. We determined that can we look at the story through the lens of Jesus. When we consider this story in light of the cross, we find that there's a different lesson to be learned about God's character and God's posture toward us when we sin.

✓ Reflect

- What picture of God do you have when you make mistakes?
- The ancient world did not have the benefit of the picture of God that Jesus completed for us. If you were trying to make sense of the world without the illustration of God's character that we see in Christ, you might assume that natural disasters were God's way of communicating displeasure. When you consider how Jesus responded to people who struggled with sin, what questions surface about the explanation of the flood by the ancient Jewish religion?
- Read John 8:1-11 about the woman caught in the act of adultery.
 - What was Jesus' reaction to the crowd leaving?
 - What does this imply regarding his feelings about the law that dictated stoning?
 - What do the actions of Jesus tell you about the true nature of God?
- Reflect on a time you were offered grace and patience when you did not deserve it; now imagine God offering you the same grace and patience when you sin. How does this change your picture of God?
- Have you ever felt grief when someone continues to make poor choices?
 Do you grieve out of hatred and dislike or do you grieve out of love? Can you believe that God grieves because God loves you?

Merciful God, enlighten me about how to understand these important ancient stories. Help me to always keep the example of Christ in the forefront of my mind when I am seeking to learn more about who you are. Thank you for the love of Christ in the world and the example of mercy you have clearly shown us through the cross. Amen.
