✓ THOUGHT "No one lights a lamp and hides it in a clay jar or puts it under a bed. Instead, they put it on a stand, so that those who come in can see the light." [NIV] When you receive a wonderful gift, you show others out of sheer excitement! What better gift than a Savior? DIGGING DEEPER

✓ Intro Revelation is a challenging portion of the Bible to understand. There are many ways to interpret the text but what truth can we take away that is practical for us today? John's advice to the church begs the question for us--how are we different because we choose to follow Christ? How are we a light, changing the world for the better rather than just fitting in?

✓ Reflect

- When you think of the book of Revelation what comes to mind? After hearing this week's message, what new ideas have surfaced?
- It is a delicate balance to stand out in our culture in a positive way. We want to be relevant and connected but also remain a light in the darkness. How have you navigated this in your life of faith? What are good examples of this that you have seen in others? Have you seen damaging examples of Christians "standing out"?
- In John's revelation, Jesus was speaking to the church of Laodicea. They had become complacent. Revelation 3:15-16 says, "I know all the things you do, that you are neither hot nor cold. I wish that you were one or the other! But since you are like lukewarm water, neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of my mouth!" [NLT] Reflect on your faith journey. Would you say that presently your spiritual life feels hot, cold, or lukewarm? Can you identify a reason?
- In Revelation 3:19-20 we see Jesus encourage them saying, "I correct and discipline everyone I love. So be diligent and turn from your indifference. Look! I stand at the door and knock. If you hear my voice and open the door, I will come in, and we will share a meal together as friends." [NLT] When we lose our way and fail to follow Christ, Jesus is always there knocking, calling us out of our indifference. What changes do you think Jesus might be nudging you toward? What steps can you take this week to keep from being indifferent to what God wants?
- We are called to be difference-makers. What passions for your community need to be reignited? What issues break your heart? Pray that God would show you a place to serve!
- ✓ Pray Holy Spirit, help me begin each day with a prayer of surrender. I want to listen to your Holy Spirit nudging me, so give me the courage it takes to step out and make a difference. Open my mind to new ways I can serve and be a light to others. Amen.
