## ✓ DISCUSS

• In the conclusion to last week's story, we find that God makes a way back to the Israelites, but it wasn't immediate. There was a lot of waiting involved and we can only imagine how that felt for them. Describe a time you felt like you were stuck with nothing to do but wait for a change in your circumstances. How did you stay hopeful during that time?

- Our tendency is to try to keep things in our lives under control and predictable. God's fierce love is sometimes described as untamable. What would it look like to loosen your grip on a situation that troubles you?
- Jesus ruffled a lot of feathers because his ways were unexpected. Some were so angered by this out-of-the-norm influence that they tried to cage it and control it to the point of ultimately putting him to death. But we know that was not the end of the story. How does the resurrection of Jesus characterize the nature of God? In your life, do you expect God to do things that are bigger than your understanding, or do you try to keep God in a box?
- Community is essential to our faith. When we are there to encourage others
  and can receive that same encouragement, we are strengthened and better
  equipped to press on through dry times. Discuss how this has played out in
  your life.

God, we thank you for this community of people who come together to help and strengthen each other. Guide us and help deepen our faith as we learn how to navigate through difficulties and trials. Give us the perseverance to maintain hope in your power that is working in our lives. Amen.
