DIGGING DEEPER

▼ Intro

We live in a noisy culture. Whether it's the tv, cell phone, or social media, we are constantly bombarded with voices. Most of these voices are suggesting that we do something. If we want to listen to God and respond, we must first adjust our surroundings.

▼ Reflect

- When you spend time with God, do you spend more time talking or listening? Why?
- What things in our lives distract us most from hearing from God?
- Read 1 Samuel 3:1-10 aloud.
 - Why do you think the Lord called to Samuel, the boy, instead of Eli, the priest?
 - How did Samuel's surroundings help him hear from God?
 - If you decided to commit yourself to listening to God on a daily basis, what distractions would you need to eliminate?
 - What is keeping you from making some tough decisions about your schedule and habits to allow for this time?
- As Christ followers, we have an inherent clear purpose of loving others, but we each have our own unique, God-given abilities and individual roles to play. We must regularly listen to God to truly understand who we were created to be. Do you feel you have a good handle on this? Why or why not?
- Personal vision statements help us connect the small decisions in our lives to our larger purpose. It helps clarify our "why." Consider spending time with God, specifically, considering your personal values, strengths, and goals. Write a vision statement, knowing it may be a work in progress.
